Pat Paton was our mini speaker for April and gave an interesting talk about how she immigrated on her own to NZ at age twenty. She came over by ship on the famous white P & O Ocean Liner Canberra. A trip she enjoyed immensely.

Neil Phillips, the Curatorial Manager at the Canterbury Museum gave an interesting, and very extensive, pictorial presentation showing the history of when all of the many buildings making up the Rolleston Ave Museum complex were built. This began back in the 19th Century, moving progressively through the 20th Century, to the current extensive redevelopment of the museum.

He also showed us how the new museum will look when it's all finished and reopens in 2029.

Although closed for a number of years during the redevelopment, 71 staff are kept very busy looking after the (in storage) collection and planning and preparing for the future of the redeveloped museum.

Quake City, Ravenscar House and the Museum popup in the COCA building in Gloucester Street will remain open during the rebuild period.
